Bob Paisley was a soccer player and manager. He was born in England in 1919. At school, he was a star player and his team won many competitions. However, when he left school he was told he was too short to be a professional soccer player and he had to find another job. He played soccer with an amateur* team until 1939, when he joined Liverpool Football Club. In 1951, he became Liverpool's captain.

He retired as a player in 1954, but stayed with Liverpool as a trainer. He became known for helping the players to improve their fitness and skills. In 1974, he was asked to become Liverpool's manager. In the next ten years, Liverpool won almost every competition. Liverpool won 20 trophies* with Paisley in charge of the team.

When he retired at the end of 1983, Paisley had been working at Liverpool Football Club for 44 years. Paisley was the most successful English soccer manager ever, and one of the most successful in the world. After he retired, Paisley worked in television and radio. He was good at explaining soccer, and people enjoyed listening to him talk about his career. He was married and had three children. He wrote a book about his life in 1983. Bob Paisley died in 1996.
